**CIRCULAR FOR STUDENTS**

Sub: Reopening the University in a phased manner for face-to-face mode of teaching - Regarding

Ref: Memo.No.3724/SE.Prog.II/A1/2021, dated 24.08.2021

In compliance with the Memo in the reference cited, the University will be reopened partially, in a phased manner, for in-person classes (face-to-face mode of teaching) from 06 September 2021, as resolved by the Standing Committee of the Academic Council at its Meeting held on 25.08.2021.

The following decisions have been taken by The Standing Committee of the Academic Council:

1. In the first phase, the University will be reopened to all the M.A. students pursuing various courses at the Hyderabad Campus. The University will be opened for the PhD and UG students (including B.Ed. English) at Hyderabad in the next phases. Hence, the classes for UG courses (including B.Ed. English) and PhD guidance shall continue to be offered through the online mode only.
2. To ensure health and wellbeing of the students and staff, students permitted in the first phase only will be allowed entry into the Campus. The UG and PhD students will not be allowed entry into the campus until further orders.
3. The Regional Campuses of the University at Shillong and Lucknow will be reopened for all the students pursuing UG and PG courses, and PhD programmes for face-to-face mode of teaching/research guidance. However, the timings of the instruction shall be decided by the Directors of the Regional Campuses, in due compliance with the local protocols / guidelines laid down by the respective State governments.
4. The M.A. students who have taken admission to university hostels can arrive at the University campuses between 01 and 05 September, 2021 since the in person teaching will commence from 06 September, 2021. A separate Circular will be issued pertaining to online admissions into university hostels.
5. All the foreign students, irrespective of the courses they are pursuing at this University will be allowed into the University Campus from 1 September 2021.
6. All those students who are granted permission to attend classes in person are required to produce a genuine Negative RT-PCR Test report at the time of entry into the University. The test should have been conducted not more than 72 hours before the time of reporting at the University. Reports found to be fake or false will attract severe disciplinary action.
7. The students who come to the Campus should follow the COVID protocol norms such as maintaining physical distancing, wearing a mask as prescribed, washing /sanitising hands regularly, and other rules of hygiene to ensure everybody's safety, as prescribed by the Government of India from time to time.
8. A Task Force and several other Committees will monitor the compliance with the norms. Any violation will attract severe disciplinary action.

9. It is to be noted that the University reopens its Campuses subject to the guidelines/ measures to be issued by the Gol and the State Governments from time to time for strict implementation to contain any possible surge/ recurrence of COVID-19 pandemic in the public interest.
10. In the event of surge in COVID-19 cases and in due compliance with the guidelines/ measures/ decisions of the Central Government or the State Governments, the students shall have to vacate the hostels on short notice.
11. Student/s infected by COVID-19, after arriving at the University, will be covered only as per General Insurance Council (GIC) rates fixed under Clause (n) in the Students' Insurance Policy of the University.
