Paper Code: MAJMC 303 Paper Title: Communication & Social Change

Communication and Social Change - This course will include studying various community media projects and participatory communication initiatives that view non-literate, rural poor in developing countries not as passive receivers of information, but as active producers of content. We shall also gain some basic understanding of participatory methods that are useful for engaging in development work and research. Providing an interdisciplinary overview of the theoretical traditions in media studies, this course will give a practical exposure to the students regarding specific campaigns involving public participation so that they gain both an understanding of academic research traditions as well working knowledge of the field. The course will aim to synthesize the material and present it in a conceptually organised manner by reducing disciplinary jargon.
